Tennis Season Wrap up

The Jordan Jaguar tennis season came to an end at the individual section tournament at Gustavus last week. The Jaguar tennis team had arguably the best season in Jordan tennis history, Sweeping the MRC schedule 7-0 and finishing the State Class A regular season ranking at #9.

Volleyball Playoffs:
