How do I set up an account? Request a unique Activation Key from the District Office. Where do I find helpful tips? Parent resources can be found on the district website under Departments > Technology Services.	Parents can sign up to receive Google Classroom email summaries which include: • Missing work • Upcoming work • Class activities • NOTE: email summaries do not include grades
Is there a mobile app? Yes. It is a third party app with limitations.	How do I receive email summaries? Contact your student's teacher(s).

Does each parent/guardian get their own access to the Infinite Campus Parent Portal?

Yes, each parent/guardian will receive individual and secure access. With the code you will be able to access private information about your student. Activation keys will not be given over the phone, to a spouse, or to a student.
