Reflective Statement of Professional Accomplishment & Assessment of Professional Growth

To meet the requirements of license renewal, a written statement is needed that demonstrates personal reflection on your professional accomplishments and summarizes a self-assessment of your professional growth.

- 1. Please begin your reflective statement with a topic sentence that introduces the subject of your statement. Some suggested topics are:
 - a. Support for student learning. (In what ways to you support student learning in your daily teaching?)
 - b. Use of best practice techniques and their applications to student learning. (What do you do that is considered to be "best practice," and how do you apply this in your classroom?)
 - c. Collaborative work with colleagues that includes examples of collegiality, such as attested-to committee work, collaborative staff development programs, professional learning community work.
 - d. Continual professional development, such as job-embedded or other ongoing formal professional learning, including coursework.
- 2. Next, include one to three paragraphs that explain and/or support your topic.
- 3. Finally, write a concluding paragraph that summarizes your statement.

Your statement need not be more than one page in length, and will be worth 1 CEU for renewal purposes. Your reflective statement qualifies as a category "G" CEU.
