




# REQUIRED COURSES





The following courses will be requested for you. Every 8th grade student is required to take...

- Language
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies

### **EXPLORATORY COURSES**

Every 8th grade student will be scheduled into the following required Exploratory Courses.

- Physical Education
  - Full Year, Every other day
- Health
  - Full year, Every other day

- Industrial Education
  - Full Semester
- STEAM 8
  - Full Semester









## **ELECTIVE COURSES**

Elective courses are courses that students request or elect to take at JMS.

It is important to remember these electives are requests and are not guaranteed.

This is why we always choose "alternates" in the event that a course is unable to fit in your schedule for any reason.

# Why is the word REQUEST important?

# It is important to remember that these electives are requests and are not guaranteed.

An elective may not work in your schedule for several reasons, the biggest one being that you may qualify for an academic support course that has to be in place of your electives.

# What if I need a support class?

If you are a student who meets the criteria for an academic support course, these may be scheduled during your elective hour. This will mean you may not have an elective class.

We still need you to make your elective request so that it is on file depending on where you are scheduled.

Support courses include any reading, math, or IEP goal support!

## WHY/WHY NOT 8TH GRADE SPANISH

#### Foreign Language

- NOT a requirement to graduate High School
- Sometimes required to get into college

#### High School credit

- The grade you receive will be reflected on your high school transcript
- You can choose to wait to take Spanish until high school!
- A difficult, high school level class with pre-requisites to be in the class

#### College Credits at JHS

- If you take Spanish in 8th grade it opens up opportunities to gain free college credits at JHS by continuing with Spanish
- By taking in middle school it opens elective options later in High School

#### Lose elective opportunities at JMS

- Choir or Band is still available during WIN time
- No other electives this is an everyday class

# **Spanish Trip**


- Need to complete Spanish 1 and Spanish 2 in order to qualify for the spanish trip
