Exploratory Courses

What is an exploratory course?

The goal of exploratory classes at the middle level is to provide a diverse exploratory option for ALL students at JMS. These classes capitalize on the curiosity of middle level learners while exposing them to a wide range of topics in order to see new ideas or skills they may not know they have.

All students will take exploratory courses.

Exploratory Courses

All 6th grade students will take these exploratory courses*:

- Physical Education
- Art
- Technology Formatting and Application
- Elective wheel
 - Game Based Problem
 Solving
 - Building and Design
 - Fitness & Recreation
 - Skills for Success

Exploratory Courses

All 7th grade students will take these exploratory courses*:

- Physical Education
- Media Production & Application
- FACS
- Exploratory Spanish

All 8th grade students will take these exploratory courses*:

- Physical Education
- Health
- Industrial Technology
- Technology Essentials

*If you are a student who meets the criteria for academic support courses, these courses may be scheduled during your elective or exploratory hour. This will mean you may not have an elective or exploratory class.

Elective Courses

Elective courses are courses that students *request* at Jordan Middle School.

<u>It is important to remember these</u> <u>electives are **requests** and are not</u> <u>guaranteed</u>.

This is why we always choose "alternates" in the event that a course is unable to fit in your schedule for any reason.

Elective Courses



Grades 5 & 6:

Choose between Band, Choir, or Band AND Choir

<u>Grades 7 & 8:</u>

Choose 4 elective options (2 per semester) AND 3 alternate options

Why or Why not Spanish in 8th grade?

• Foreign Language

- NOT a requirement to graduate High School
- Sometimes required to get into college

High School credit

- The grade you receive will be reflected on your high school transcript
- You can choose to wait to take Spanish until high school!
- A difficult, high school level class with pre-requisites to be in the class

College Credits at JHS

- If you take Spanish in 8th grade it opens up opportunities to gain free college credits at JHS by continuing with Spanish
- By taking in middle school it opens elective options later in High School

• Lose elective opportunities at JMS

- Choir or Band is still available during WIN time
- No other electives this is an everyday class
