

Senior Privileges Permission Form

Seniors who have met a set of criteria will be offered	the opportunity to sign out of one study hall
per day. Senior privileges will start	for students who have been approved by
the principal. Seniors who have excessive absences	or who have been suspended will not be
granted privileges immediately.	

To be eligible for Senior Privileges, seniors must meet ALL the following standards:

- 1. Students must have attained 18 credit at the beginning of their senior year and 21 at the beginning of the second semester of their senior year.
- 2. Students must demonstrate responsibility by maintaining passing grades, being positive role models, and sustaining a good attendance record.
- 3. Students may have only **one study hall**, unless they have an advanced class that is worth more than one credit.

The procedure:

- 1. This form must be returned to the principal signed by a parent/guardian.
- 2. Wait for approval for the principal.
- 3. Students who have been approved must sign in the office each day prior to leaving for Senior Privileges.
- 4. Seniors who choose not to go on Senior Privileges should report to study hall.
- 5. Seniors should return to the building on time for their class following Senior Privileges.

Senior Privileges will be removed under the following conditions:

- 1. A teacher sees that a student is falling behind academically.
- 2. Attendance or behavior issues arise.
- 3. A student returns from Senior Privileges late.
- 4. Seniors leave for lunch.
